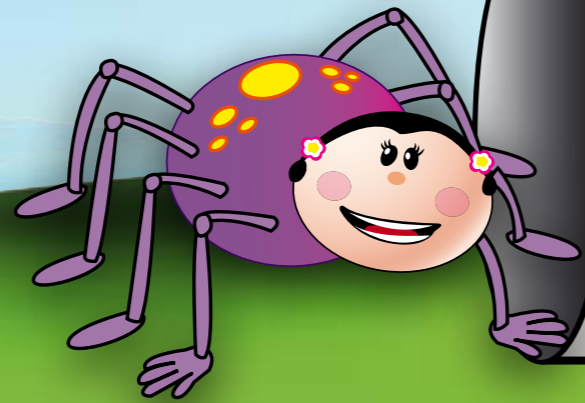

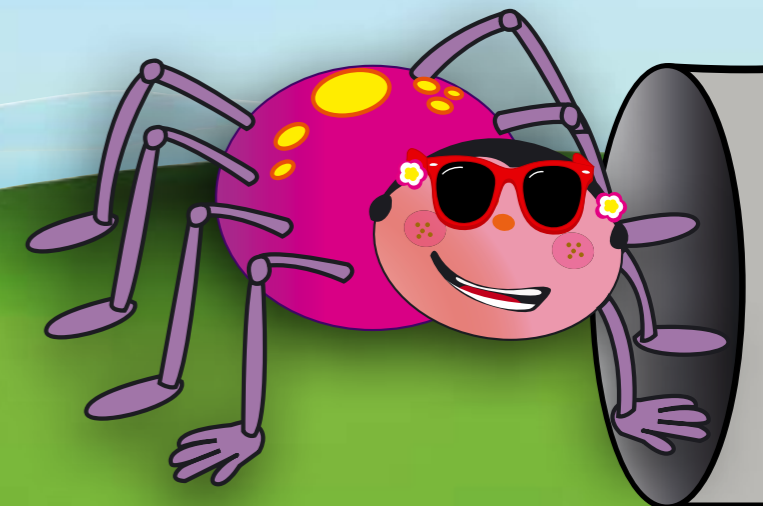

and all of them were cool.

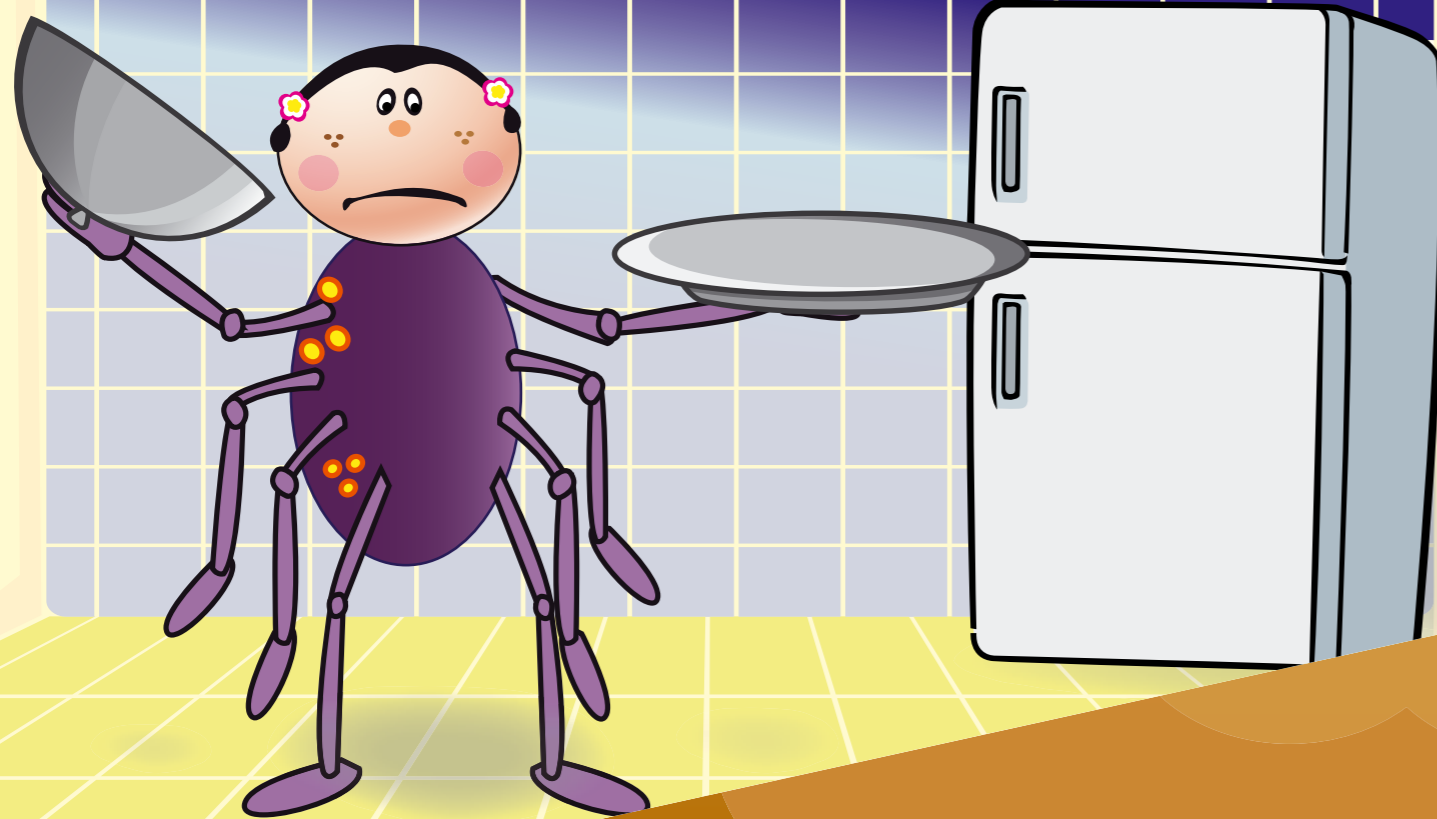
She sat in the front row

and she could see the stars.



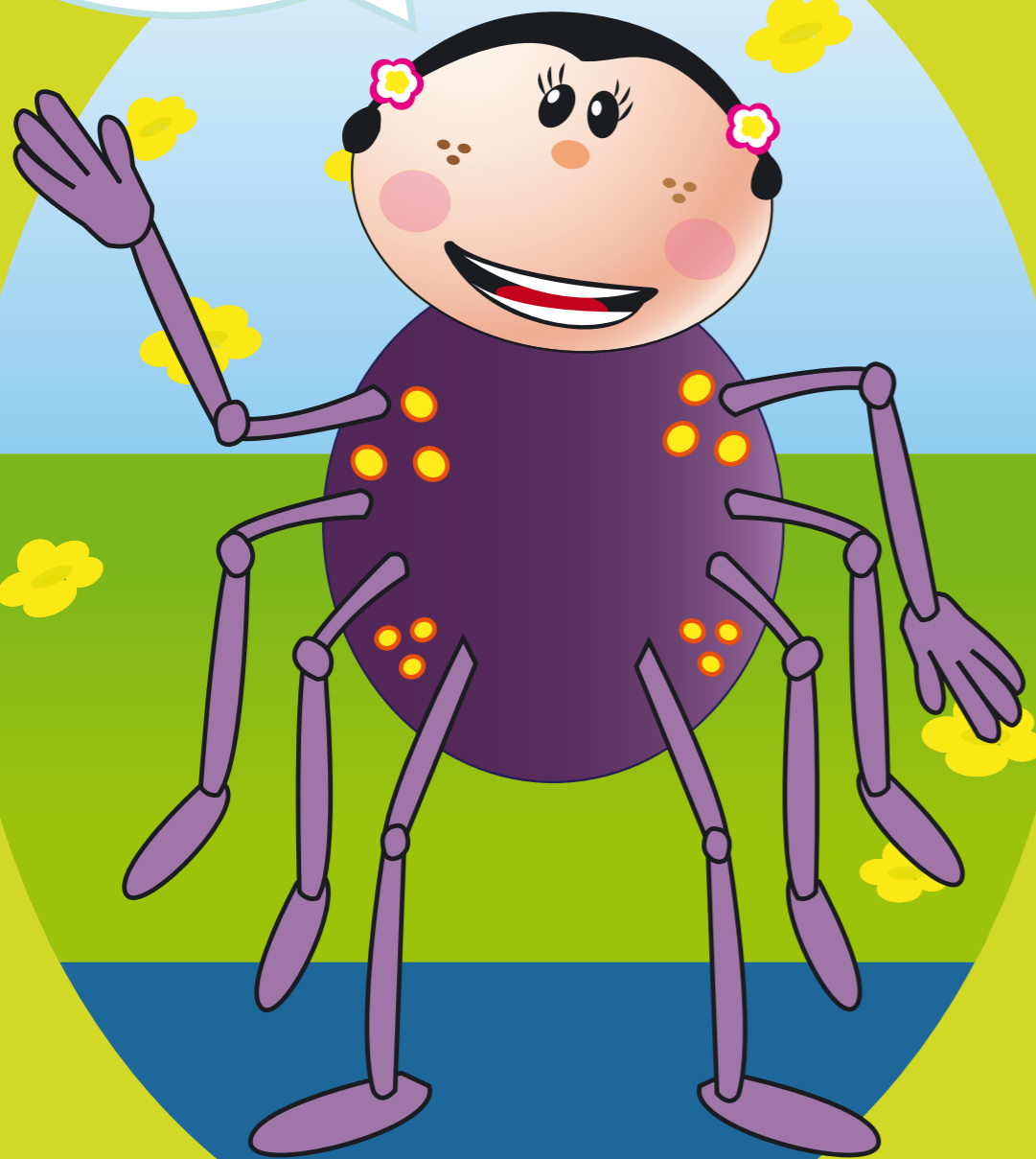

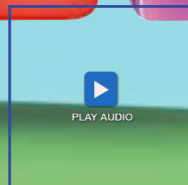


Sing Along

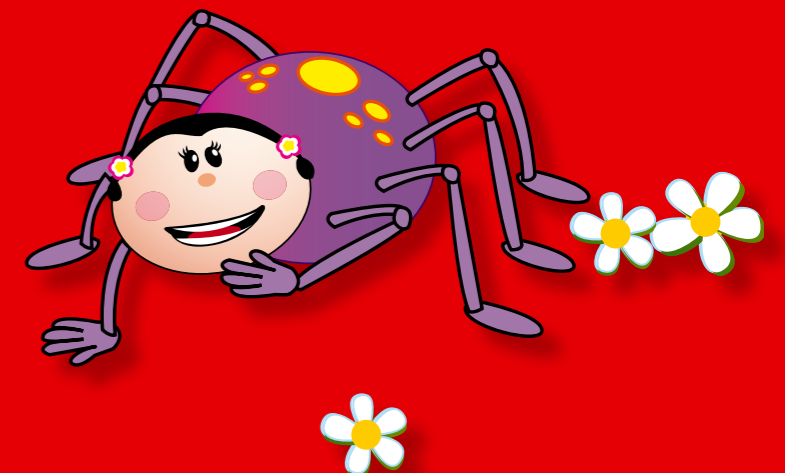
